He also advised me that the Queens delegation of the City Council has included the project in a request to the Speaker of the New York City Council. The Council Member has also written a letter to Congress Member Grace Meng in an effort to secure federal funding for the Motor Parkway. If you have called his office, thank you. If you haven't please call your elected officials in Queens and let them know how important the Motor Parkway is to you and the community.

While our membership continues to grow, I would really like to thank Lynn Henry for all the work she does as our Membership Chair. Lynn is great at engaging new members and supports our club almost every day.

Late breaking update: Council Member Barry Grodenchik made an announcement after Mike's article was submitted that he has now secured \$1.25 million dollars for the Vanderbilt Motor Parkway. The estimated cost of the project is around \$5 million dollars. The Council Member is a big advocate for our park and hopefully with his help and additional funding the Motor Parkway will get repaved and extended.
